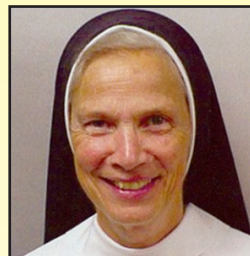

Mother Assumpta is the Prioress General of the Dominican Sisters of Mary Mother of the Eucharist in Ann Arbor, Michigan. She holds an S.T.L. in Sacred Theology from the Pontificat University of St. Thomas in Rome. The Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist was founded in 1997 by Mother Assumpta and three other Dominican Sisters; the community has experienced phenomenal growth, expanding from 4 to 99 sisters in 12 years. The community's primary apostolate is Catholic education in the spirit of the New Evangelization; fully Dominican in spirituality, the two distinguishing marks of the community's charism are devotion to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist and total consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Sisters operate the Spiritus Sanctus Academies, two K-8 Independent Catholic schools in Southeast Michigan, and also have Sisters teaching at the elementary and secondary level in the dioceses of Phoenix, AZ, Charleston, SC, Sacramento, CA, Austin, TX and Venice, FL. The Dominican Sisters of Mary are committed to the reclamation of a truly Catholic culture through education, igniting one soul at a time with love for Jesus Christ and His Church.
