Home Educator Workshop -Application Package

The NAPCIS Home Educator Workshop (HEW) covers much the same material that is found in our on campus Teacher Certification Program for member schools. The materials consist of a syllabus and bibliography for the course of study, various study guides, a reader of Magisterial writings on education, and some materials pertaining to what we call the pedagogical option (e.g., essays on Dominican educational principles). Many of the necessary and recommended texts for the program are available for separate purchase from various sources.

The cost for the basic HEW, consisting of syllabus, bibliography, study guides and Magisterial reader is \$200.

A home school teacher seeking participation in the NAPCIS HEW is required to submit this completed agreement, registration, and questionnaire form. It helps NAPCIS both understand the background, training, experience, and pedagogical orientation of the participating teacher; and also better assist the home school teacher in forming his program of study.

By signing this registration form, participants indicate that they understand that NAPCIS is neither a curriculum provider for primary or secondary home education nor a school for primary or secondary students. They also indicate awareness that NAPCIS neither “certifies” nor “credentials” home school educators. Rather, NAPCIS recognizes and supports the certification that comes from both the natural and supernatural orders through the state in life of the parent and the vocation of Holy Matrimony.
